- 3. Students must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on the weighted scale
- 4. Students must have a passion for the art of performance.
- 5. Students do **not** need to be planning to major in music after High School.

This scholarship is a yearly, \$500 scholarship awarded to a passionate senior choir member, chosen by a committee of teachers. The scholarship will be awarded at the Lancaster High School Spring concert. **Application is due by March 8, 2024** and needs to be turned in to the Fairfield County Foundations office at 162 East Main Street Lancaster, Ohio 43130 by either mailing or dropping in the mail slot at the door.
