Local Entrepreneurs Establish B More Foundation, Offer Challenge to Raise \$1 Million for Baltimore over Next 10 Years

LANCASTER, Ohio --The Fairfield County Foundation is pleased to announce the development of two new funds as part of the B More Foundation, established by Baltimore, Ohio natives and Outerbelt Brewing co-owners Robert and Davey Landis. Proceeds from the funds, an unrestricted fund and a permanent endowment fund, may be awarded to any individual, business or organization that has a need or project that enhances the community of Baltimore, Ohio or its residents.

The Landis brothers each made a \$100,000 gift to seed the fund. They have established a goal of raising \$1 million for the fund over the next 10 years, and would like to find 10 donors who will commit to donating \$10,000 per year for 10 years in order to do so.

"I am motivated by a desire to give, but have wrestled with how to do it in a way that can have a real impact. I believe there are many people in my community who feel the same way," said Robert Landis. "My goal is for this to turn on a light and build awareness in the community of what we can accomplish together. If you have a desire to give, now there is an option that is specific to our community. If you have a need for funding or an idea, now there is a fund dedicated entirely to enhancing Baltimore. It's a win for everyone!"
