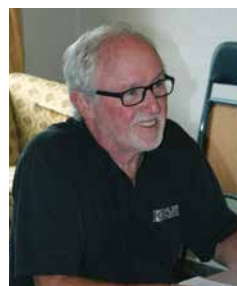

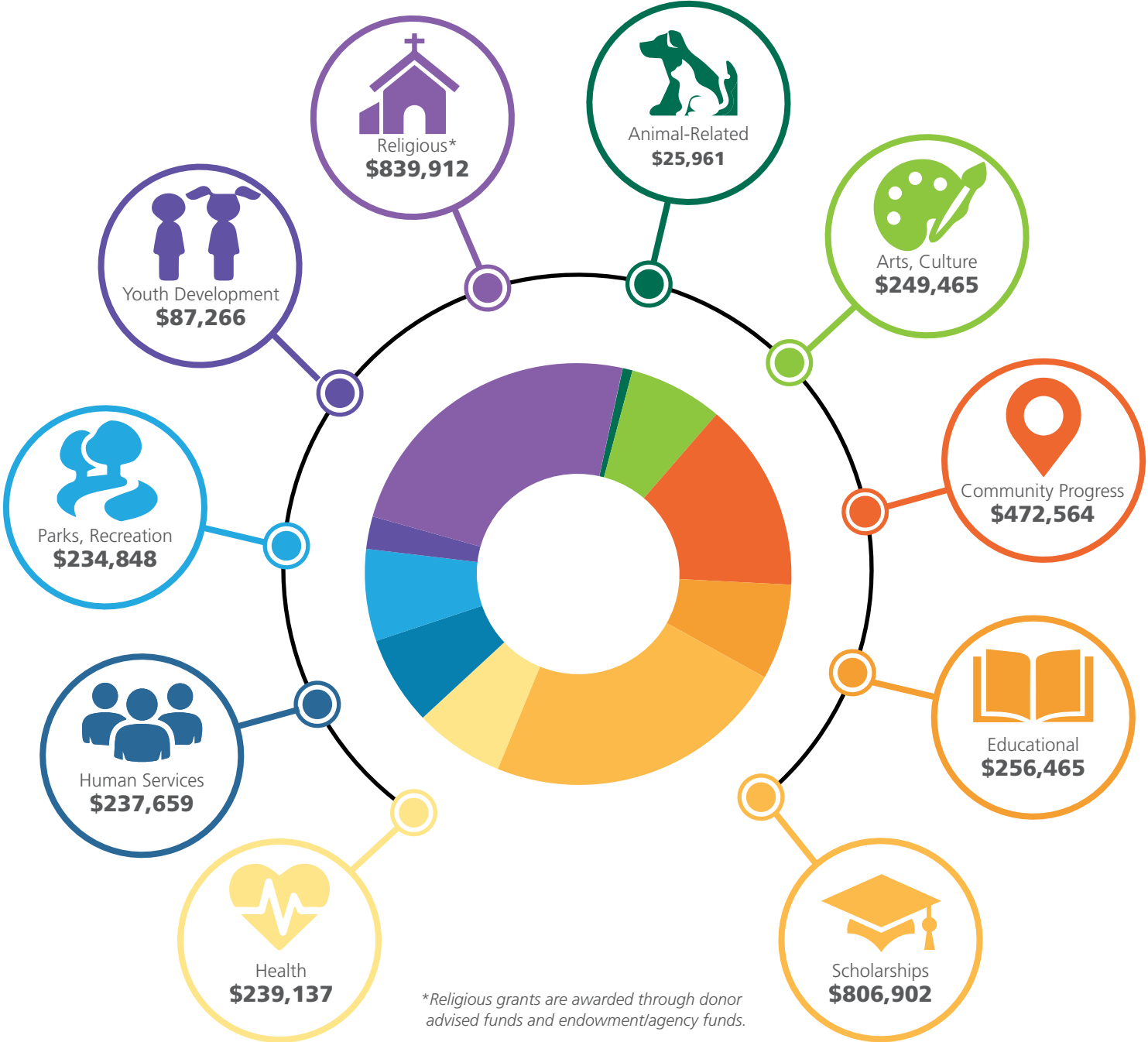

# GIFTS







## Setting up a Fund with the Foundation

Your Foundation is here to help you build your legacy. We can help you determine your charitable goals, such as deciding if you want family members involved, both now and/or in the future; consider how much involvement you want in selecting the charitable organizations that will receive grants from your fund; and think about how much you want to give in charitable contributions each year and how you want to give it.

We make giving easy and effective, accepting a wide variety of gifts and providing donors with a number of charitable options. Our professional staff has in-depth understanding of the issues, opportunities and resources that shape our community. The Foundation has several options for setting up a fund that best meet your giving goals, including the following:

- **Donor-Advised Funds:** This type of fund enables donors or their designees to recommend grants based on their personal charitable interests.
- **Unrestricted Funds:** Unrestricted Funds are gifts to the Foundation's unrestricted general fund. The principal and income is distributed at the Foundation's discretion in the form of grants to 501(c) (3) organizations. A minimum gift of \$5,000 is required to establish a named fund. Gifts of any amount are accepted into the general fund.
- **Scholarship Funds:** Individuals, families, companies or organizations can establish Scholarship Funds. Once in place, a Scholarship Fund continues to grow with additional contributions from the original donors, from other contributions and through market growth. The donor of a Scholarship Fund has the ability to define the scholarship's advisory committee and the guidelines for candidate selection, requirements and award use.
- **Agency Funds or Endowments:** Agency Funds or Endowments can be created to perpetually support your community service agency. Agency funds hold assets for a charitable organization and distribute the principal or earned income in accordance with the agency's specific instructions.
- **Designated Funds:** Designated Funds are established to ensure that support will be provided to specific eligible non-profit organizations, often organizations that donors have been involved with during their lifetimes. This is an opportunity to leave a lasting legacy in the donor's name.



## Making a Gift to the Foundation

A variety of assets can be used to make charitable gifts and there are many ways that you can give immediately or in the future.

- **Cash:** Cash gifts are an easy way to make an impact in your community and allow you to give at any time.
- **Securities:** Securities, both publicly traded and closely held, can be used to set up a fund.
- **Real and Personal Property:** Gifting real and personal property often allows an individual to contribute more than they may have thought possible.
- **IRA/Retirement/Pension Fund Assets:** Retirement assets are most often used as testamentary gifts, creating charitable funds as part of an overall estate plan.
- **Life Insurance:** Life insurance makes it possible to make meaningful gifts to the community.
- **Unique Assets:** Examples might include stamp, coin or art collections; copyrights and patents; royalties; or other unique assets of value.
- **Wills and Bequeaths:** Bequests offer varied ways of giving to the Foundation. Cash securities or other property may be bequeathed in one's will.
- **Charitable Remainder Trusts:** A Charitable Remainder Trust provides life-long income for one or several income beneficiaries, such as the donor and the donor's spouse, and leaves the remainder interest to the Foundation or designated beneficiary.
- **Charitable Lead Trusts:** The income generated from assets placed in a Charitable Lead Trust is paid to the Foundation for a period of years, after which the trust is terminated and the assets are returned to the donor.
- **Charitable Gift Annuities:** The Charitable Gift Annuity can make it possible for donors to assist the community in the future while providing lifetime income for themselves. Upon the death of the donor, the remaining principal is retained by the Foundation to carry out the donor's charitable intentions.
- **Transfer of a Private Foundation:** This type of gift affords many advantages, including lower overhead, staff to assist with charitable goals, and a higher tax deduction for any future gifts, to name a few.

## Kiwaniis Club of Lancaster

In 2019, Kiwanis Club of Lancaster reached a major milestone of turning 100 years old. To commemorate their centennial, the club wanted to perform a large project that would exemplify Kiwanis and its mission to support the underserved children in the community. They decided to build an All-Abilities, Multi-Generational Playground at Hunter Park, which was once described as underutilized and underdeveloped. The playground opened to the public in October 2019.

The Foundation donated a total of \$60,000 from the George and Dollie L. Zimpfer Memorial Fund to install a soft, solid rubber surface underneath the playground equipment. This feature allows for children with wheelchairs and other mobile devices to have full access to the playground.

“We have never done a project this big, not in the whole 100 years,” said Joan Miller, Club Secretary of Kiwanis Club of Lancaster. “It was a big year for us. A once-in-a-lifetime project for our club.”

The Foundation played a special role in this project, not only by donating the funds but also through setting up the Kiwanis Special Fund and – what Miller describes as one of the most important factors – recommending a fiscal agent for them to receive donations. The Friends of Lancaster Parks and Recreation acted as the club’s fiscal agent and as a partner, contributing both financially and promotionally to the project.

***“Not only did the Foundation give us a grant but they really guided us through the whole project so we were able to get funding from other places,” says Miller. “They really were a partner through this whole process.”***





# FUNDS







### Donor-Advised Funds

This type of fund is one of our most appealing charitable vehicles. Donor-Advised Funds make possible several options, such as: making a charitable gift now; the ability to make suggestions regarding which charities you would like to support; setting up a fund through your will/estate; and naming certain people as advisors to your fund. Donors receive both tax and philanthropic benefits in a simple format with a high degree of flexibility.

**John and Marcia Baughman Family** – to benefit St. Mary of the Assumption Church’s special liturgical operating fund, “For the Honor of God;” the Ohio University Foundation via the Baughman Family Scholarship Fund at OU-L; the Fox Family Y’s Partner for Youth Fund, and the Fairfield County Foundation’s Ambassadors’ Fund.

**Blue Label/One Write** – this fund shall be used for the purpose of benefiting the residents and organizations of Fairfield County.

**Christian Stewardship** – to provide financial assistance for charitable causes, not exclusively, but with emphasis on supporting Christian-based efforts such as evangelism, missionary support, and providing for the needy both within and outside Fairfield County.

**Allison Lynn Conover Memorial** – to assist families with ill children from Pickerington and surrounding communities; to make monetary donations to hospitals (Nationwide Children’s Hospital and The Ohio State University Pediatric Resident Scholarship Fund) and to give tangible items to the hospital to benefit patients and families that are currently residing there; and to match a dance scholarship for a student at the Judy Dollenmayer Studio of Dance.

**The Buckeye Lake Region Community Foundation** – to provide financial assistance needed by the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation to coordinate, manage and execute initiatives that support the Buckeye Lake 2036 Vision and the Buckeye Lake Region Declaration.

**Donley Family** – distributions shall be made primarily to charitable organizations which provide services primarily in the area of Pickerington or Violet Township, Ohio.

**Charles and Diana Eversole Family** – to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County, Ohio, for public, charitable and educational purposes, with special consideration given to the Fairfield Heritage Association and matching funds to the Fairfield Medical Center Foundation.

**Hubie and Jenny Eyman Memorial** – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the residents of Fairfield County.

**Lorelei and David Gibbs Family** – to support charitable organizations.

**Great Commission** – to support charitable organizations and to further the teachings of Jesus Christ, whether local, national, or worldwide.

**The Rotary Club of Lancaster-Sherman Fred & Margie Hatcher Endowment** – to support the needs of the Lancaster and Fairfield County community.

**Harcum Family** – to provide financial assistance for charitable organizations.

**Heiber Family** – to be used for public, charitable and education purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the residents of Fairfield County.

**Lloyd F. and Diann L. Helber** – to support charitable organizations.

**Tina Rose B. Herrmann and Kody Alexander Maynard Healing Hearts Memorial** – to provide grants and assistance to help victims of violent crimes.

**Jackson Family** – to provide charitable programs which will aid the children and aged of Fairfield County and Bloom Township.

**David L. Johns** – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes for Fairfield County.

**Jennie L. Johns** – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit for the people of Amanda, Ohio.

**The Maggie Fund - Maggie Grace Lyons Memorial** – to provide scholarships to Fairfield County students (up to age 21) whose siblings have special needs and/or have severe medical issues. Scholarships can pay for college, camps, classes (i.e. art, music, etc.).

**Jayne and Jim McGill Family** – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the children in Fairfield County, Ohio.

**Terry A. McGhee/Sally J. Grimm Community** – to be used for public, charitable and educational purposes.

**Mowry Family** – for public, charitable, and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County.

**Ninety One: One Foundation** – for the purpose of benefiting the residents and organizations of Fairfield County.

**Norman Family** – for public, charitable and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County.

**Joe Ogilvie** – to benefit Duke University, The Inner City Educational Foundation, and grants for educational endeavors in Fairfield County and elsewhere.

**Lauryn “Lu” Oliphant Memorial** – to provide grants to benefit the residents of Fairfield County or those organizations supported by the Donors and/or to award scholarships to students graduating from Pickerington High School, Pickerington, Ohio.

**Pickering Family** – to provide funds for charitable purposes in Fairfield County.



**Rodenbaugh Family** – to provide funds for charitable and educational purposes.

**Wayne Roller Memorial** – to provide support for grants and scholarships for students, athletes, coaches, teams and officials.

**Wanda Shaner Memorial** – to provide grants and/or scholarships to benefit the residents in Fairfield County.

**William J. and Sarah E. Sitterley** – for public, charitable, and educational purposes to provide an ultimate benefit to the people of Fairfield County, Ohio.

**Brian Stoner Memorial** – to provide funds to charitable organizations that are eligible to receive distributions. Preference for grants goes to organizations dealing with individuals with special needs. Preference for scholarships goes to individuals with autism, individuals with other special needs, individuals intending to major in special education, and individuals attending culinary school.

**Rich & Delores Troup Family** – to provide funds for charitable purposes in Fairfield County.

**Vonnie Cares Community Impact** – to provide grants to Fairfield County High School students who have a GPA of 3.0 or higher for the purpose of funding a community project to strengthen community relations, to encourage giving and recognize the kindness of others.

**John and Jamie Weaver** – to make grants to charitable organizations for the purpose of benefiting the residents of Fairfield County and other charitable causes.

**The Weiffenbach Family** – to make grants to charitable organizations for charitable purposes.

**Williamson Family** – to provide funds for charitable purposes.

## Scholarship Funds

Scholarship funds help students pursue their academic goals. The donor may define the guidelines for the recipient, the advisory committee, the school and the award itself.

**Matthew Acton** – to provide scholarships for senior golf athletes of any Fairfield County High School, Canal Winchester High School, Circleville High School, Logan Elm High School or Teays Valley High School. This scholarship is for any accredited college or vocational school.

**The Anderson/Black/Community (ABC) Mini-Scholarship** – to provide scholarships to two Bloom Carroll High School students, staff members, administrators, or retired staff members who had five years of service to the Bloom-Carroll Local School District to fund a Christian Mission Trip (CMT) or a Christian Mission Project (CMP).

**Roger Anderson** – for students residing in Jackson Township of Perry County and majoring in education or business.

**The Aranda Notre Dame Law School** – to provide scholarships to students who have been accepted to the Notre Dame Law School.

**James L. Barrett, M.D.** – to provide scholarship assistance to graduates of a Fairfield County High Schools to attend the University of Cincinnati and major in computer science, geology, physics, chemistry, or mathematics.

**Bashore College Trust Fund Scholarship** – to provide scholarships for Richland Township residents.

**Paul D. Beck** – to provide scholarships for graduates of a Fairfield County, Ohio high school who demonstrate academic ability and maintain a 3.5 GPA in high school and a 3.0 GPA in any undergraduate program.

**Bloom-Carroll Alumni Scholar Athlete** – for Bloom-Carroll graduates who participate in sports and also demonstrate academic excellence.

**William W. Bolsen Memorial** – to provide scholarships for graduates of the Ohio State School for the Blind who wish to work toward a degree from a technical, two-year or four-year college.

**Marlowe Brainard** – to provide a scholarship for students graduating from Millersport High School who desire to continue their education in the field of Arts or Education.

**Jean M. Burdette Memorial** – for Lancaster High School graduates for study in the field of Special Education.

**Glenn R. Burns Dental Education** – for residents of Fairfield County who are seeking a degree in Dentistry, Dental Hygiene, or as an Expanded Function Dental Auxiliary.

**James Caple** – to provide scholarships for post-secondary studies for Fairfield County residents who pursue a course of study in classical vocal or instrumental performance.

**Robert E. & Marion A. Carr** – for Fairfield County residents who are pursuing a degree in the study of Nursing and/or Teaching/Education.

**Molly Ann Clark Memorial** – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for students between the ages of 17-21 who are from Fairfield, Perry, Pickaway, Hocking, Licking, Athens or Muskingum county. They must demonstrate an interest in community service and volunteerism; be a past participant (racer) of the Lancaster Soap Box Derby, past Derby queen or have had a family member who either volunteered or served on the board of directors of the Lancaster Soap Box Derby. Applicants meeting the above criteria will be given preference in determining recipients, or a student seeking a degree in substance abuse education may be accepted every even year.

**Charles C. & Barbara Claypool** – for students seeking educational opportunities in technical fields with a preference toward engineering. Preference given to the children of employees of Claypool Electric Inc. and students planning to attend Ohio Northern University.

**Deputy Ethan Collins** – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited school or academy in preparation for a career in Law Enforcement or continuing education in Law Enforcement.

**Coney Memorial** – for Fairfield Union High School graduates.

**Susie McMackin Crook** – will be awarded to a student who has registered and been accepted at Lancaster Montessori School.

**D.A.R.E.** – scholarship recipient shall be a graduating senior from Lancaster High School, William V. Fisher Catholic High School or Fairfield Christian Academy and a graduate of the D.A.R.E. Program who desires to continue his or her education.

**Davidson-J.C. Community Service** – to provide scholarships to students of Fairfield County who demonstrate an interest in community service through volunteerism. Jaycees and relatives of current or former Jaycees will be given preference in determining recipients.

**Jillian Davidson Memorial** – this fund was established by family and friends to honor the memory of Jillian Leigh Davidson who died of a rare blood disease in September 2000. This scholarship is awarded to a female senior basketball or volleyball athlete at Lancaster High School. This award is given to the individual selected by the Davidson Scholarship Committee.

**Elsie R. McClelland Davis Memorial** – for graduates of Amanda-Clearcreek High School.

**Jim DePietro** – for the purpose of providing educational scholarships for college students in the manner described: 1. Applicant must be a high school senior and a Lancaster Y Swim Team (LYST) swimmer. 2. LYST swimmer must have been a participant of the LYST program for at least two years, prior to application. 3. Seniors wishing to apply will be asked to write an essay, using an essay prompt determined by the (active) LYST Parent Board Committee.

**Frank Dillard Memorial/Standing Stone National Bank** – for graduates of Fairfield County High Schools. Preference given to biological or legally adopted dependents of Standing Stone National Bank employees. Weighted toward those who plan to major in Business/Finance at Ohio University Lancaster.



**Charles E. Dupler** – to provide financial assistance to Fairfield Union High School music and F.F.A. students.

**Chad Edwards Memorial** – to provide scholarships for Fairfield County students to attend an accredited school or academy in preparation for a career in law enforcement or to further their career in law enforcement.

**Leroy and Bernice Ellinger Memorial** – for any graduate of a Fairfield County high school or any graduate from a high school in Worthington, Ohio. Preference will be given to a graduate of Lancaster High School. Applicant must be a college junior or senior and preference given to an accredited four-year college. Recipient must have at least a 2.75 GPA going into their junior year.

**Fairfield County Educational Service Center Superintendent's Scholarship** – for students within Fairfield County based on academic and athletic achievement.

**Amelia Fickel - Glenn Moodie** – to provide scholarships for graduates of Perry-Southern Local School District. Special consideration given to graduates who are residents of the former New Straitsville School District. Selection shall be based on financial need. May be awarded for a four-year, two-year vocational or technical college education.

**George and Marilyn Finnen Education** – to provide scholarships for Lancaster High School graduates majoring in the field of Education. This fund was established by a gift from George Finnen in memory of his wife Marilyn.

**Wilfred and Una Fosnaugh** – for residents of Fairfield County, Ohio pursuing a bachelor degree in Education at any accredited educational institution and is need based.

Recipients must volunteer in their community for a certified 501(c)3 organization for a minimum 20 hours in the prior 12 months from submitting the application and must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

**Lancaster Kiwanis Club** – for students graduating from a high school located in Fairfield County, Ohio.

**Erik J. Landis Memorial** – to provide scholarships for graduating seniors from Fairfield Union High School who will be attending an accredited educational institution. Recipients will be chosen based on academic merit, economic need, and community involvement.

**Jamey Landis Memorial** – to provide scholarships to Fairfield County high school seniors who participated in track, cross country, or FFA.

**Malinda Lifer** – for recent graduates of Bloom-Carroll High School or Lancaster High School who plan to major in elementary education at Ohio University Lancaster.

**Liberty Union Alumni Association** – to provide scholarships for Liberty Union High School graduates.

**Frank P. Maguire** – to provide scholarships to students who graduate from a high school in Fairfield County, Ohio whose parent(s) served or are serving in the U.S. military.

## Foundation Saves Thousands of Dollars for Food Kitchen

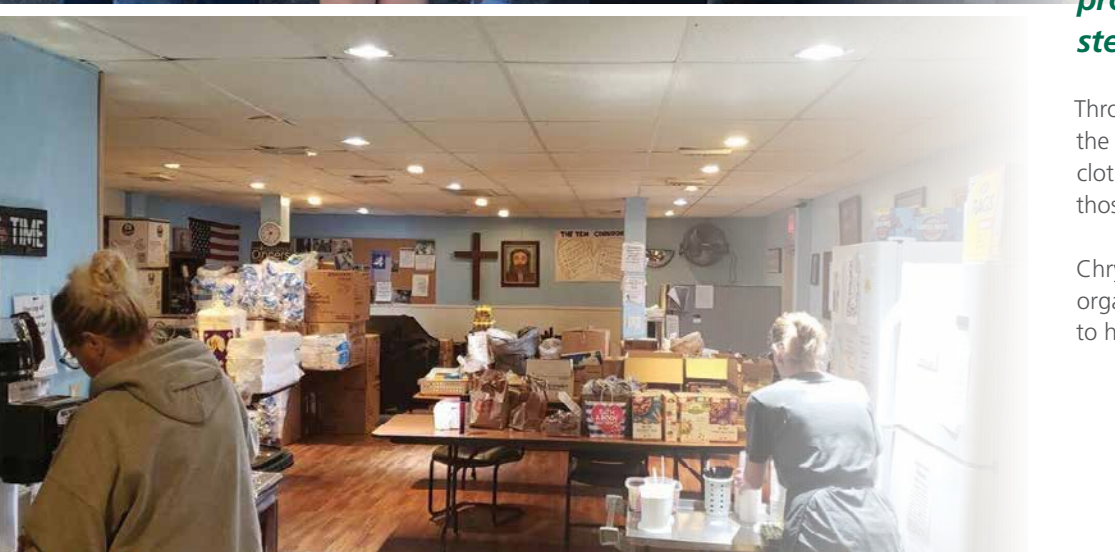
For over 30 years, Foundation Dinners has lent a helping hand to members of the Fairfield County community and beyond who struggle to find their next meal. Serving over 3,500 people each month, Foundation Dinners provides exceptional, nutritious meals during lunch and dinner hours to anyone in need. The food they prepare is donated by several generous churches, local businesses, restaurants, anonymous donors and more, ensuring they have the capacity to keep up with their growing demand.

One half of the building they operate out of was donated to them in 2011. They rented the other half of the building, which was a major expense they had to cover each month. With the help of the Fairfield County Foundation, they received a grant for \$40,000 from the George and Dollie L. Zimpfer Memorial Fund and the PNC Martens Fund to purchase the second half of the building, saving them approximately \$8,000 a year.

***“They are fantastic... I can’t say enough good things about the Foundation,” said Rick Chrysler, Foundation Dinners director. “It’s not just the money they donated to us, but the wonderful assistance they provided. Anytime there was a problem or I didn’t fill something out correctly, they would steer me in the right direction.”***

Throughout the years, Foundation Dinners has provided more than just meals. During the winter months, they give out over 500 pairs of donated socks, gloves, hats and other clothing items. They also provide occasional counseling and employment to support those facing adversity.

# Investing in Hope and Opportunity

## for Youth and Women in Our Community

The Women's Giving Circle, a component fund of the Fairfield County Foundation, is a volunteer led and member managed giving circle whose main purpose is to connect, invest and inspire hope for youth and women in Fairfield County by awarding grants to local non-profits. No volunteering, no event planning, no silent auction donations to solicit.

The Women's Giving Circle meets three times per year for a one hour meeting and each member is asked to contribute \$100, making the total annual contribution \$300. These meetings bring women together to learn more about issues impacting women and youth in our community and generate the resources utilized to address the unique needs the group decides to support. Through collaboration and the relationships developed in the circle, we can have a greater impact than we might otherwise have alone.

At their first meeting in September the group raised \$9,500 and decided to support Fairfield UP, an organization created to assist the most vulnerable young people in our community who are involved in the juvenile justice and protective services systems.

## Bottoms Up

Bottoms Up Diaper Drive started as an idea to help impoverished communities have better access to diapers for their children, but in just a short amount of time they were collecting and delivering more than 210,000 diapers to nearly 40 food pantries and child care facilities around Central Ohio. A grant from the Terry A. McGhee/Sally J. Grimm Community Fund allowed them to purchase more diapers and wipes to meet the growing demand in Fairfield County.

## Compassion Furniture Bank

Compassion Furniture Bank has been serving the communities of Fairfield and Pickaway County since 2018, providing furniture to those who struggle to furnish their homes due to poverty and severe life challenges. A portion of the grant they received from the Robert A. Schatz Fund was used to purchase a portable mini-split system to help control the moisture and humidity in their facility and preserve the quality of their furniture. The remainder of the grant was used to buy mattresses and frames for those in need.



## Fairfield Center for disAbilities

The Fairfield Center for disAbilities and Cerebral Palsy is a non-profit organization that strives to enhance the lives of Fairfield County residents with disabilities through programs and services that increase their lifestyle opportunities. One of those services is the Wheelchair Ramp and Home Modification Project, which gives eligible residents the ability to regain full access to their homes. Thanks to a grant from the Terry A. McGhee/Sally J. Grimm Community Fund more community members will have a better quality life as a result of this service.





## 250 Plates

# Youth Advisory Committee Encourages Philanthropy among Next Generation of Leaders

The Fairfield County Foundation Youth Advisory Committee was established in 2019 to empower Fairfield County high school students through leadership and community service. Since then, it has provided an opportunity for local students to get involved in projects that support initiatives for youth in their own communities and gain real-world experience in overseeing the financial and human resource components of a new grant cycle for youth projects.

Juniors and seniors from schools across the county make up the 12-person committee, which changes each year. Schools represented include Fisher Catholic High School, Fairfield Union High School, Berne Union High School, Fairfield Christian Academy, Lancaster High School, Pickerington Central High School and Liberty Union High School.

The Youth Advisory Committee and the Foundation's Board of Trustees launched the first Youth Project Grant Cycle with \$10,000 to support youth efforts in Fairfield County. The committee managed submission reviews, completed site visits, and made recommendations to the Board of Trustees. The Youth Advisory Committee of 2018-2019 awarded grants to seven organizations that benefit youth in Fairfield County:

- Bremen United Methodist Church on behalf of Bremen and Rushville area churches for support of the Breakfast 4U program at Rushville Middle School.
- Good Neighbors in the Village for supplies for their summer lunch program benefiting students in the Baltimore area.
- InspiHer for their 2020 inaugural leadership retreat for Fairfield County girls in grades 5-8.
- Lancaster Vineyard Church for woodworking supplies to use in their HYPE mentoring groups with at-risk youth of Fairfield County.
- Pickerington Food Pantry for funds to start their summer food program for students of the Pickerington Local School District.
- Pickerington Public Library for funds to purchase books for students as incentives in completing their summer reading program.
- Victoria Players Children's Theater for funds to purchase sound equipment for their performances.
