#### CYCLE 1:

- Preliminary Grants: Due second Monday in January January 9, 2023
- Invitations to submit full grant sent second week of January
- Grant Application: Due second Monday of February February 13, 2023
- Grant Committee recommendation to Board of Trustees for approval March 16, 2023

#### CYCLE 2:

- Preliminary Grants: Due second Monday in May May 8, 2023
- Invitations to submit full grant sent second week of May
- Grant Application: Due second Monday of June June 12, 2023
- Grant Committee recommendations to Board of Trustees for approval July 20, 2023

#### CYCLE 3:

- Preliminary Grants: Due second Monday in September September 11, 2023
- Invitations to submit full grant sent second week of September
- Grant Application: Due second Monday of October October 9, 2023
- Grant Committee recommendations to Board of Trustees for approval November 16, 2023
